Networks of Networks – Community EDI Survey

- Network of Networks discussed EDI in February 2021, focusing on how to increase diversity in our speakers. KTN has since developed a <u>speaker list</u>
- A recommendation was made that we should also find out more about the diversity of our network communities
- A small sub-group formed to create a Network of Networks survey. This was presented at the next meeting in May 2021. The final survey was distributed across the networks in July 2021 once ethics approval given
- 267 responses received







Understanding our network communities

This survey development has been led by EPSRC funded Network Plus, Connected Everything: Accelerating Digital Manufacturing Research Collaboration and Innovation (CEI). As part of the remit of CEI), a 'network of networks' has been created to accelerate collaboration and learning. This survey, developed by the network of networks, is hoping to understand more about the inclusivity of our network, so that as lockdown measures are eased, the activities offered by the networks are inclusive and representative of their communities. We will use these survey results to create a benchmark, so we can continually track our progress in terms of improving the inclusivity of our activities.

This survey is for all members of all of the networks in the 'networks of networks' and is entirely voluntary and anonymous. If will take approximately 5-10 minutes to complete. As an example of how we use survey responses, a number of networks have designed their Early Career Researcher activities based on the findings from a recent survey to respond to the needs of these specific members. 











How would you describe your ethnicity or ethnic background?





Health Conditions


Do you have an impairment, health condition or learning difference that has a substantial and long-term impact on your ability to carry out day to day activities? (Select all that apply)






Barriers & Suggestions for In Person Events

What would enable you to attend events (For example: subsided travel / event fees, childcare facilities, having funded carer place)?








Barriers vs Enablers for In Person Events

- Timings of Events! Avoid clashing with first week of term / religious events / organizing events out of core hours.
- Give LOTS of notice
- Mediated Socialising
- Help with funding for travel, registration, expenses or Free Events
- Online / Hybrid Approaches
- COVID Measures
- Help with childcare facilities
- Make events easily accessible by public transport
- Location: Don't make them all in London
- · Make the events worth going to!
